AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF CUBA, MISSOURI, ON BEHALF OF SAID CITY, TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH SHOWTIME PYROTECHNICS, LLC, FOR A FOURTH OF JULY FIREWORKS DISPLAY

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen of the City of Cuba, Missouri (City), has determined that it is in the best interests of the City to enter into a contract with Showtime Pyrotechnics, LLC for a fireworks display as a part of the City's 4th of July Celebration.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Cuba, Missouri, as follows:

Section 1: The City of Cuba, Missouri, shall enter into a contract with Showtime Pyrotechnics, for fireworks display as a part of the City's 4th of July Celebration. A copy of said Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

Section 2: The Mayor of the City of Cuba, Missouri, is authorized to execute the Agreement on behalf of the City.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

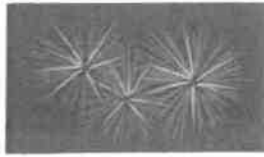

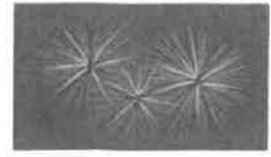

Thank you for once again for choosing Showtime Pyrotechnics for your 2020-2022 Fireworks Display. I have the Show date of Sunday evening July 3rd reserved for you. The time of the display will be approximately 9:30 p.m., and it will last approximately 25 minutes, as did last year's. The following page is the new show spec sheet for this year's show. We have another great Display planned for the community this year and are really looking forward to seeing another huge turnout...

This is also the final year of our current 3 year contract. If you would like to continue with another continuation of contract, I would be happy to extend our present arrangement for another 3 years covering display years 2023, 2024, and 2025 with slight yearly increases in increments of \$1500.00 per year respectively. This would start the 2023 display at \$21,500, 2024 at \$23,000, and bring the 2025 show in at a total cost of \$24,500.00. Prices in the Fireworks industry have jumped almost 35% in the last 2 years and shipping went from approximately \$15,000 to \$35,000 per overseas container in the past 8 months. It has been, and is a huge struggle to secure product, get it shipped, and keep costs down since the covid 19 world change, but we are doing everything we can. We are already stocked for this year's displays and working towards 2023. It's a huge benefit for us to know what shows we have a year or more out now for buying power, and it's equally as important on your end to know you are actually hiring someone that has product to set off. Fireworks of all types and sizes are in short supply and the industry trend seems to be its going to get worse before it gets better. In order to start this new 3 year extension just sign on the back page and send it with this year's deposit check. If you have something else in mind contract wise and would like me to work it up, just contact me and we will see what we can do, also if you have any questions or concerns about this year, please don't hesitate to call me. Thank you

- The display will include a 1,000,000.00 certificate of liability insurance policy.
- The display will be shot by a Missouri State Licensed Operator and Qualified Personnel only. Copies of Credentials are available upon request.
- City of Cuba must supply at least (1) fire truck to remain on scene during and up to (1) hour after the show.
- Shoot Site Plan and Shoot Specifications will be presented to local AHJ (Authority Having Jurisdiction – Fire Chief) or Missouri State Fire Marshal 30 days before show date and a signed permit issued by AHJ.
- All laws and regulations involving fireworks used in the display will be followed, this includes purchasing, permitting, insuring, firing, transporting and safety.
- In the show is cancelled due to severe weather, drought or any other unforeseen event, a rain date will be scheduled for July 5th, or other to be decided later. The display must be rescheduled and shot sometime within that same year, and cannot be carried over.
